

Public distribution System (PDS) the Program which is run by Government for distributing essential commodities to vulnerable sections of the Society.


### 1. Picture of challenges in Public Distribution system

2.1) Beneficiary authentication : installing "Point of Sale"

to swap ration card

2.2) Use of GPS : Track trucks carrying food grains
